
Parking Brake Control

Removal and Installation

- 1. With the vehicle in NEUTRAL, position it on a hoist. For additional information, refer to Section 100-02.
- 2. Remove the floor console. For additional information, refer to <u>Section 501-12</u>.
- 3. Release the tension on the parking brake cable. For additional information, refer to <u>Parking Brake Cable</u> <u>Tension Release</u> in this section.
- 4. Disconnect the front parking brake cable from the 2 rear parking brake cables at the equalizer and release the front cable from the body bracket.



- 5. Disconnect the parking brake switch electrical connector.
- 6. Remove the 2 nuts from the parking brake control.
 - To install, tighten to 17 Nm (150 lb-in).
- 7. Remove the 2 bolts from the parking brake control.
 - To install, tighten to 30 Nm (22 lb-ft).
- 8. Remove the parking brake control.
 - Position the cable and equalizer through the floorpan.
- 9. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
 - Adjust the parking brake cable tension. For additional information, refer to <u>Parking Brake Cable</u> <u>Adjustment</u> in this section.
