Removal and Installation

NOTICE: Do not remove the ignition lock cylinder and the ignition switch at the same time or damage to the column may result.

- 1. Depower the Supplemental Restraint System (SRS). For additional information, refer to Section 501-20B.
- 2. **NOTE:** The instrument cluster finish panel is held in place with retaining clips that are attached to the bezel.

Remove the instrument cluster finish panel.

- 3. Remove the floor console finish panel. For additional information, refer to Section 501-12.
- 4. Remove the LH A-pillar lower trim panel.
- 5. Remove the left center stack wing.
- 6. Remove the 2 screws and the steering column opening cover.
 - Disconnect the headlamp and courtesy light switches electrical connectors.
- 7. Remove the 4 bolts and the steering column opening cover reinforcement.
 - To install, tighten to 9 Nm (80 lb-in).
- 8. Remove the upper steering column shroud by carefully pressing the sides inward.
- 9. Remove the 3 screws and the lower steering column shroud.
- 10. Disconnect the ignition switch electrical harness retainer.
- 11. Disconnect the ignition switch electrical connector.
- 12. Release the 2 locking tabs and remove the ignition switch.



- 13. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 14. Repower the <u>SRS</u>. For additional information, refer to <u>Section 501-20B</u>.
