
Steering Column Lock Module

Removal and Installation

NOTICE: Do not remove the ignition lock cylinder and the ignition switch at the same time or damage to the column may result.

- 1. Remove the ignition switch. For additional information, refer to <u>Ignition Switch</u> in this section.
- 2. Remove the clockspring. For additional information, refer to <a>Section 501-20B.
- 3. **NOTE:** Clean all metal shavings and foreign material after cutting slots in the steering column lock module bolts.

Cut slots into the heads of the 2 steering column lock module bolts.



- 4. Remove the 2 steering column lock module bolts.
 - · Discard the bolts.
- 5. Remove the steering column lock module clamp.
- 6. Remove the steering column lock module.
- 7. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
 - Align the ribs on the steering column lock module with the window of the steering column tube.
 - Align the locating pin with the slot on the locating bracket of the steering column.
 - Tighten the 2 new bolts until the heads of the bolts shear off.
