Removal and Installation

- 1. Drain the cooling system. For additional information, refer to <u>Cooling System Draining</u>, <u>Filling and Bleeding</u> in this section.
- 2. Remove the Air Cleaner (ACL) outlet pipe. For additional information, refer to Section 303-12.
- 3. Remove the Throttle Body (TB). For additional information, refer to Section 303-04A.
- 4. Disconnect the Engine Coolant Temperature (ECT) sensor electrical connector.
- 5. Disconnect the upper radiator hose from the thermostat housing and position aside.
- 6. Disconnect the heater inlet hose from the thermostat housing and position aside.
- 7. Disconnect the bypass hose from the thermostat housing and position aside.
- 8. Remove the 3 lower thermostat housing bolts and the thermostat housing.
 - To install, tighten to 12 Nm (106 lb-in).
- 9. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
- 10. Fill and bleed the cooling system. For additional information, refer to <u>Cooling System Draining</u>, <u>Filling and Bleeding</u> in this section.
