Lumbar Control Switch

Removal and Installation

NOTE: The air bag warning indicator illuminates when the correct Restraints Control Module (RCM) fuse is removed and the ignition switch is ON.

NOTE: The Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) must be fully operational and free of faults before releasing the vehicle to the customer.

- 1. Depower the <u>SRS</u>. For additional information, refer to Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) Depowering and Repowering in the General Procedures portion of <u>Section 501-20B</u>.
- 2. Remove the clip and recline handle.
- 3. Remove the screw at the rear of the cushion side shield. Pull out on the side of the cushion side shield, release the retaining clips and pin-type retainer and separate the side shield.
- 4. Disconnect the lumbar control switch.
- 5. Release the retainers and remove the lumbar control switch from the cushion side shield.
- 6. **NOTE:** Inspect the cushion side shield retaining clips for damage. Install new retainers if damage is present.

To install, reverse the removal procedure.

7. Repower the <u>SRS</u>. For additional information, refer to Supplemental Restraint System (SRS) Depowering and Repowering in the General Procedures portion of <u>Section 501-20B</u>.
